

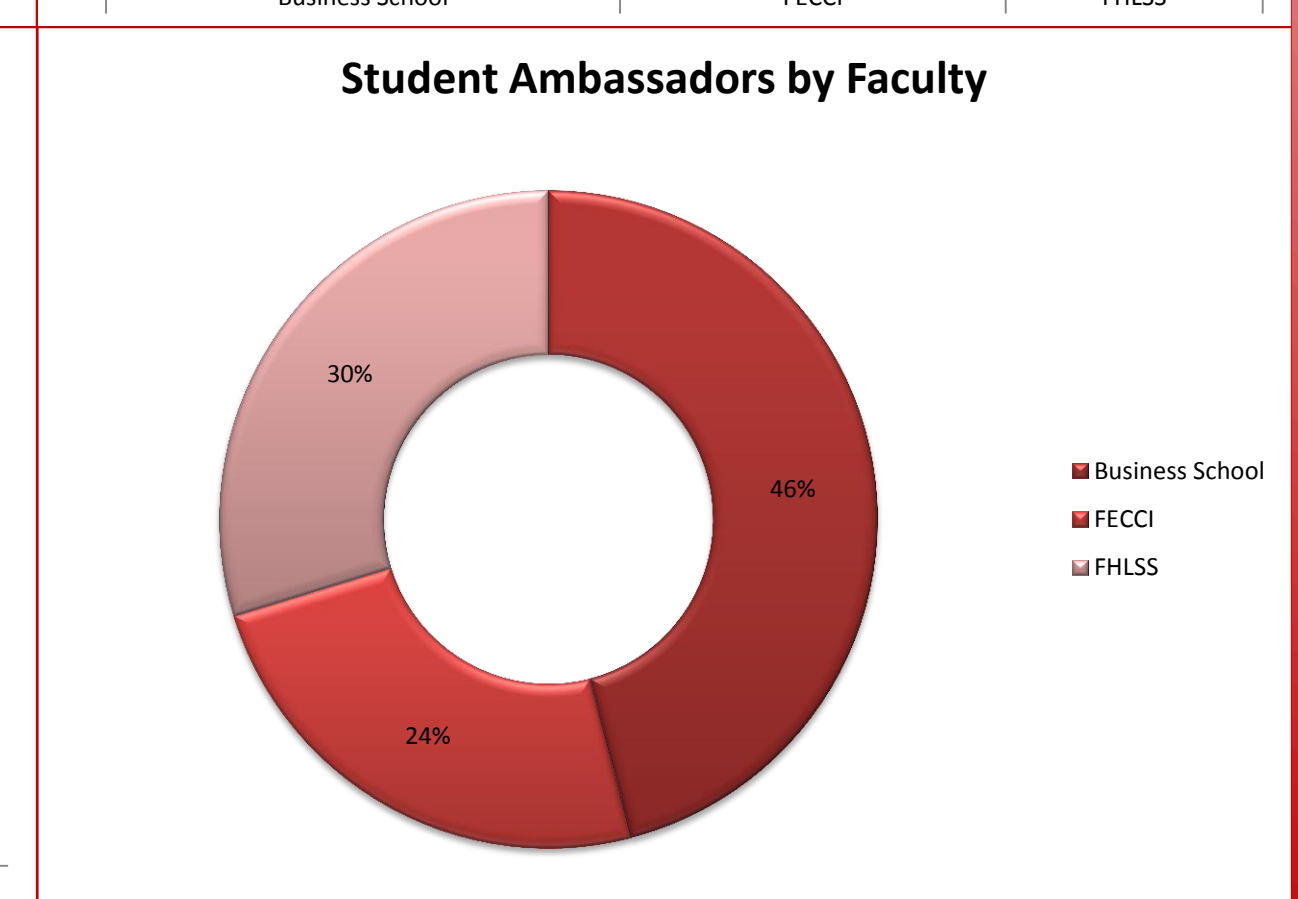
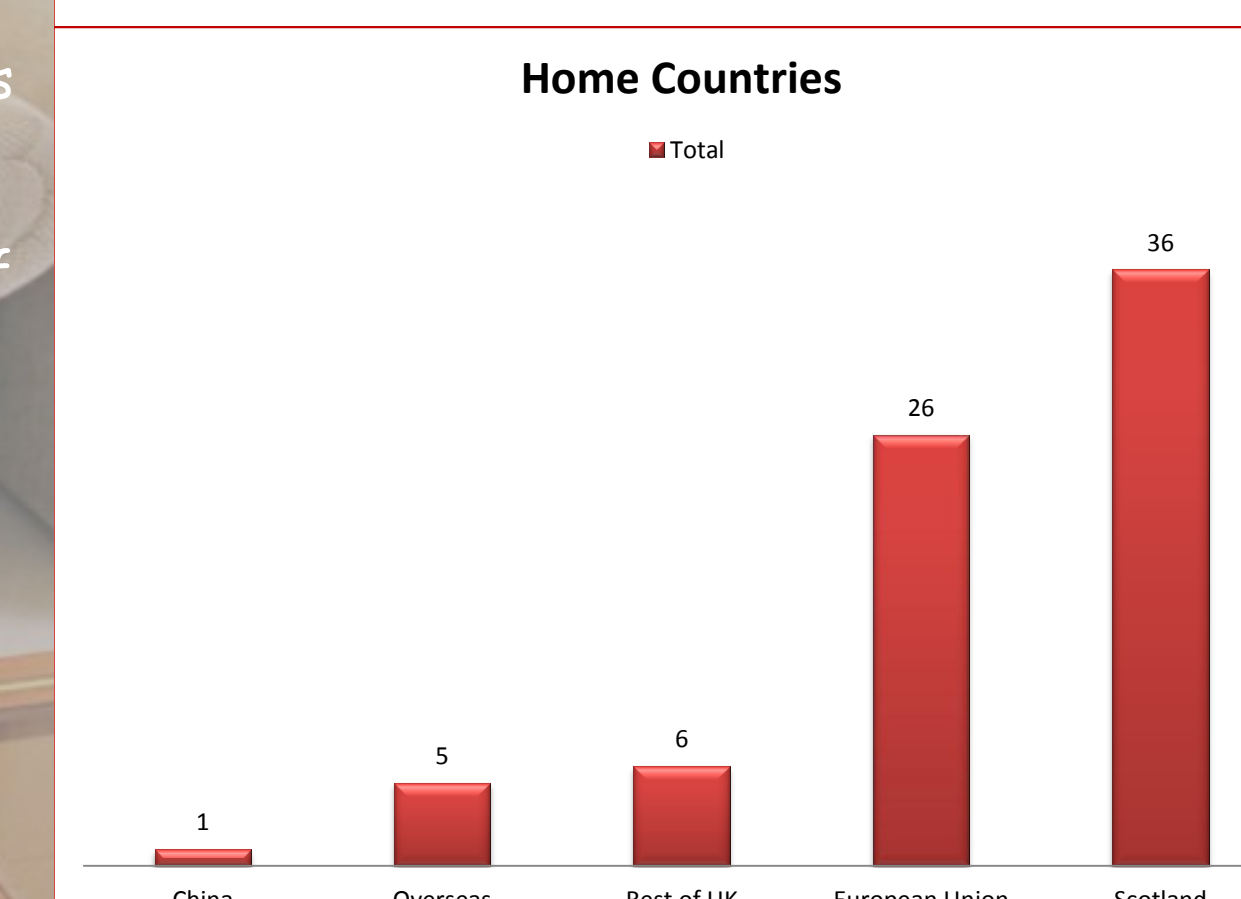
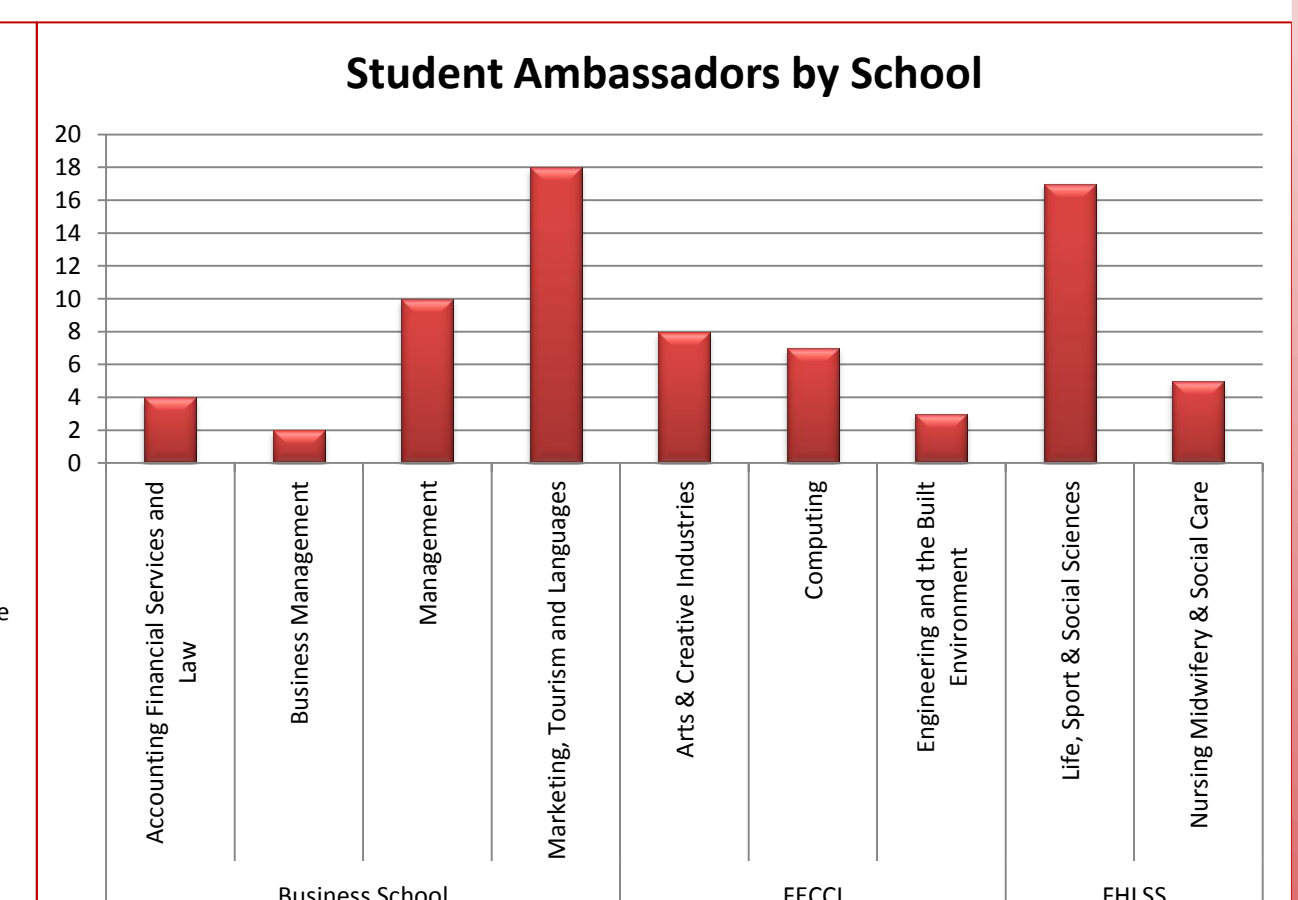
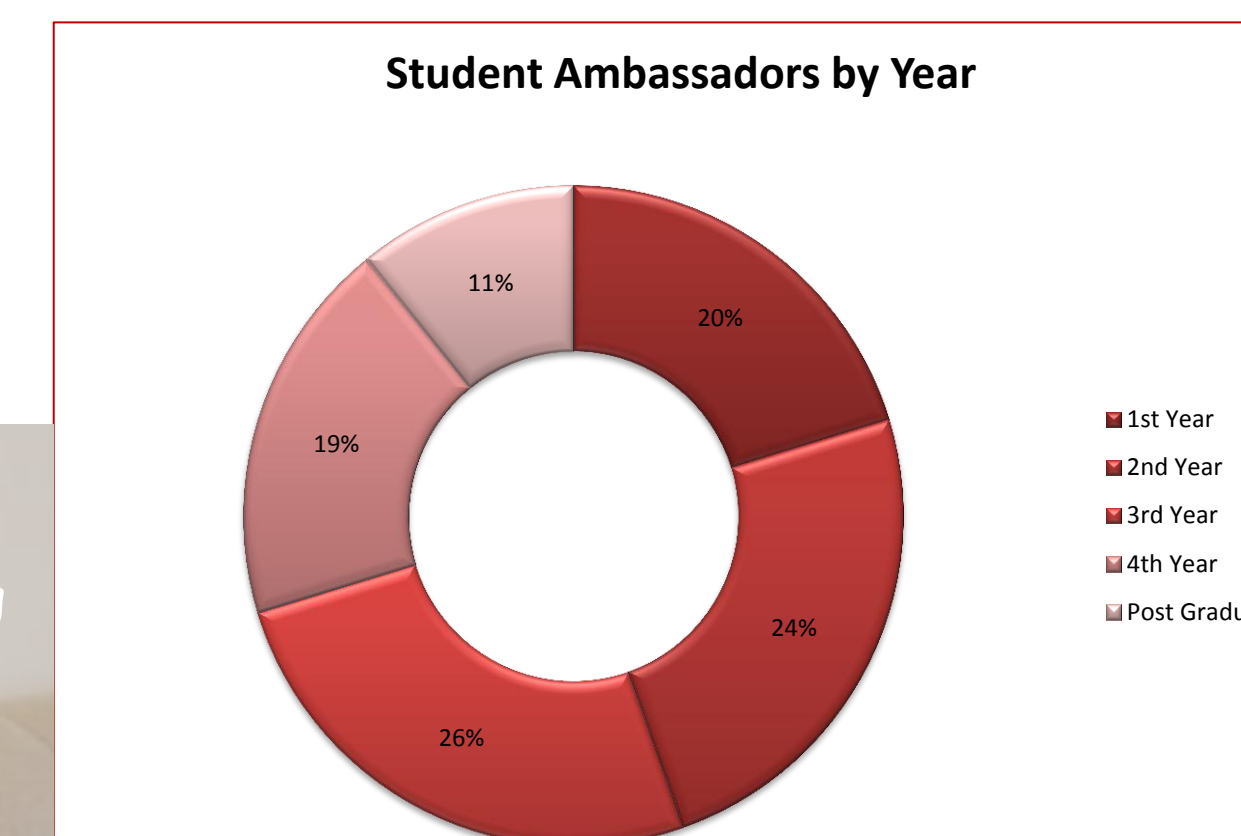


We offer current students work across different departments in Grade 2 posts. The scheme gives them the opportunity to gain experience and to enhance their graduate employability while working for and representing their university.
