
How We Support Articulating Students






Why?

Articulating students face different challenges from students who enter into year one. They are expected to familiarise themselves with:

- A new learning environment
- Less contact with staff than they may be used to
- Different teaching styles and methods
- A higher level of academic study
- An existing cohort of students

Student Articulation Advisers work with partner colleges, university staff and students to offer a range of services designed to develop and improve the student transition from college to university in order to support retention and achievement.
