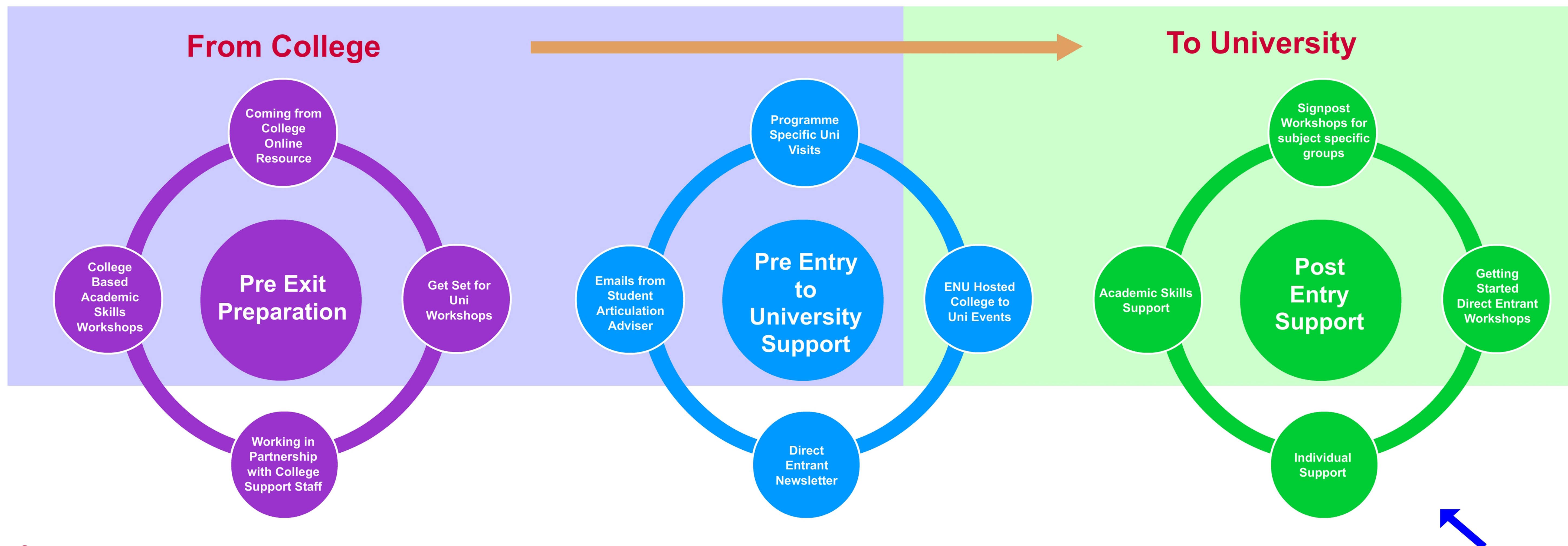


How We Support Articulating Students

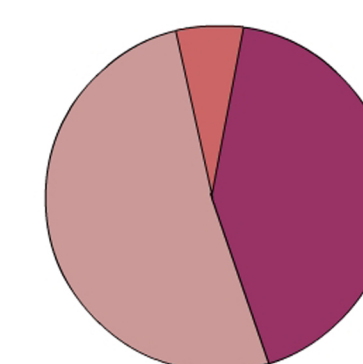
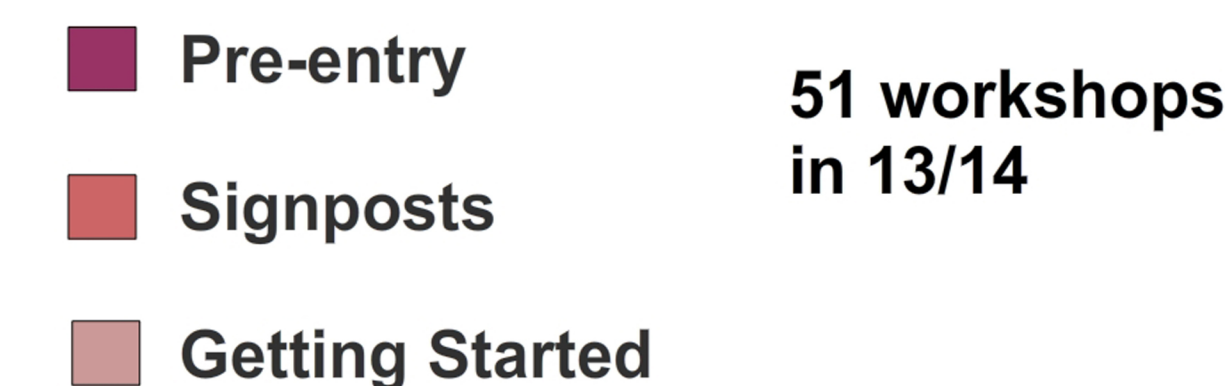
The Student Articulation Advisers are developing and piloting a new support model for articulation students.
