- Key points
 - Read the Funder Guidelines
 - Does your idea fit the Funder's criteria?
 - Is it an online application system? Are you registered?
 - Contact your Director of Research to discuss the funding
 - Does it fit with the School Strategy/your Personal research plan
 - Contact your Research & Innovation Manager
 - RIO will advise on all aspects of the funding, including costing & pricing
 - Start early
 - all RCUK applications must be peer reviewed so need to be ready at least 3 weeks before the deadline
