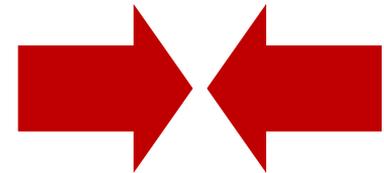

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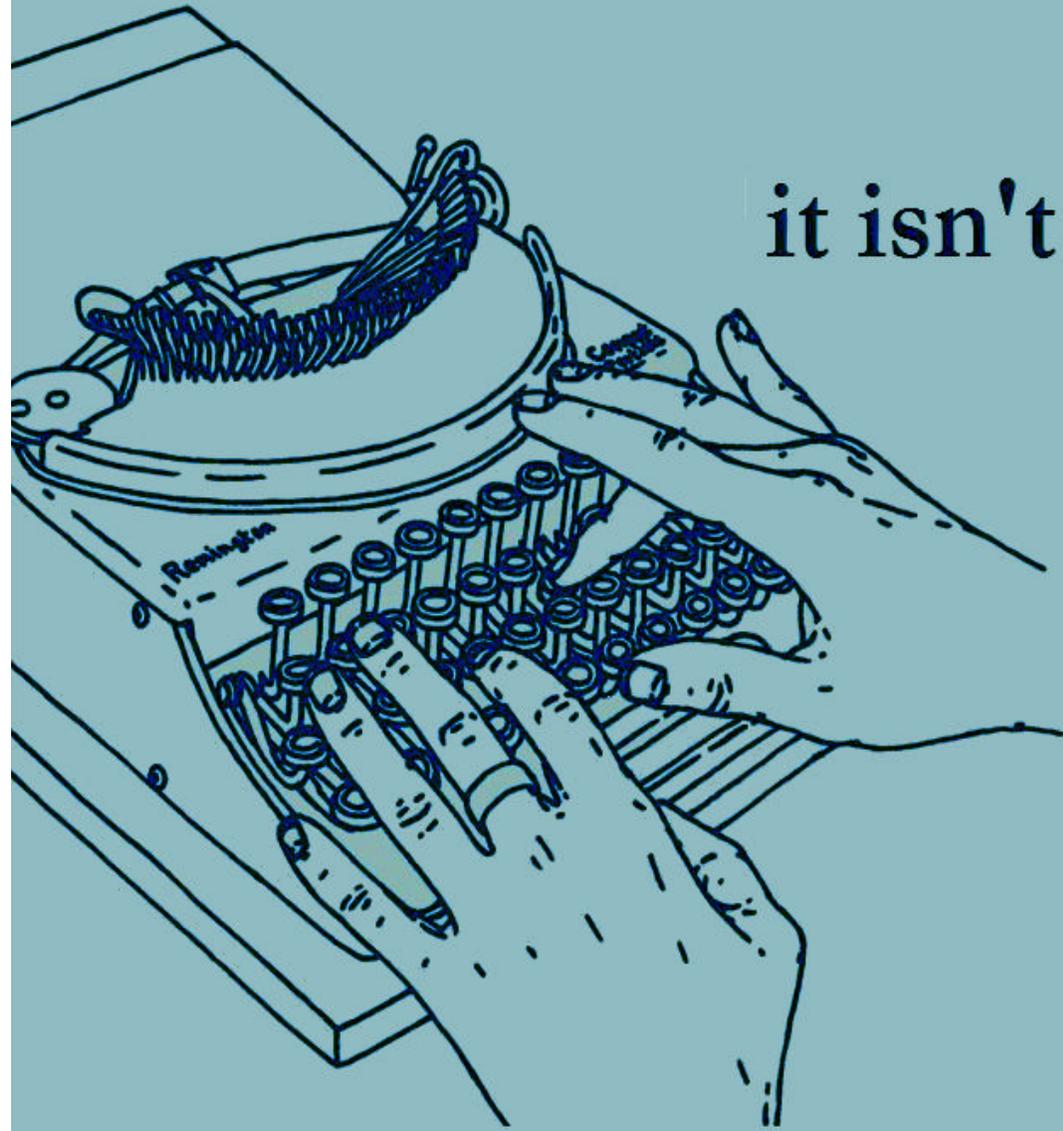
Writing groups

- **Thesis Tuesdays**

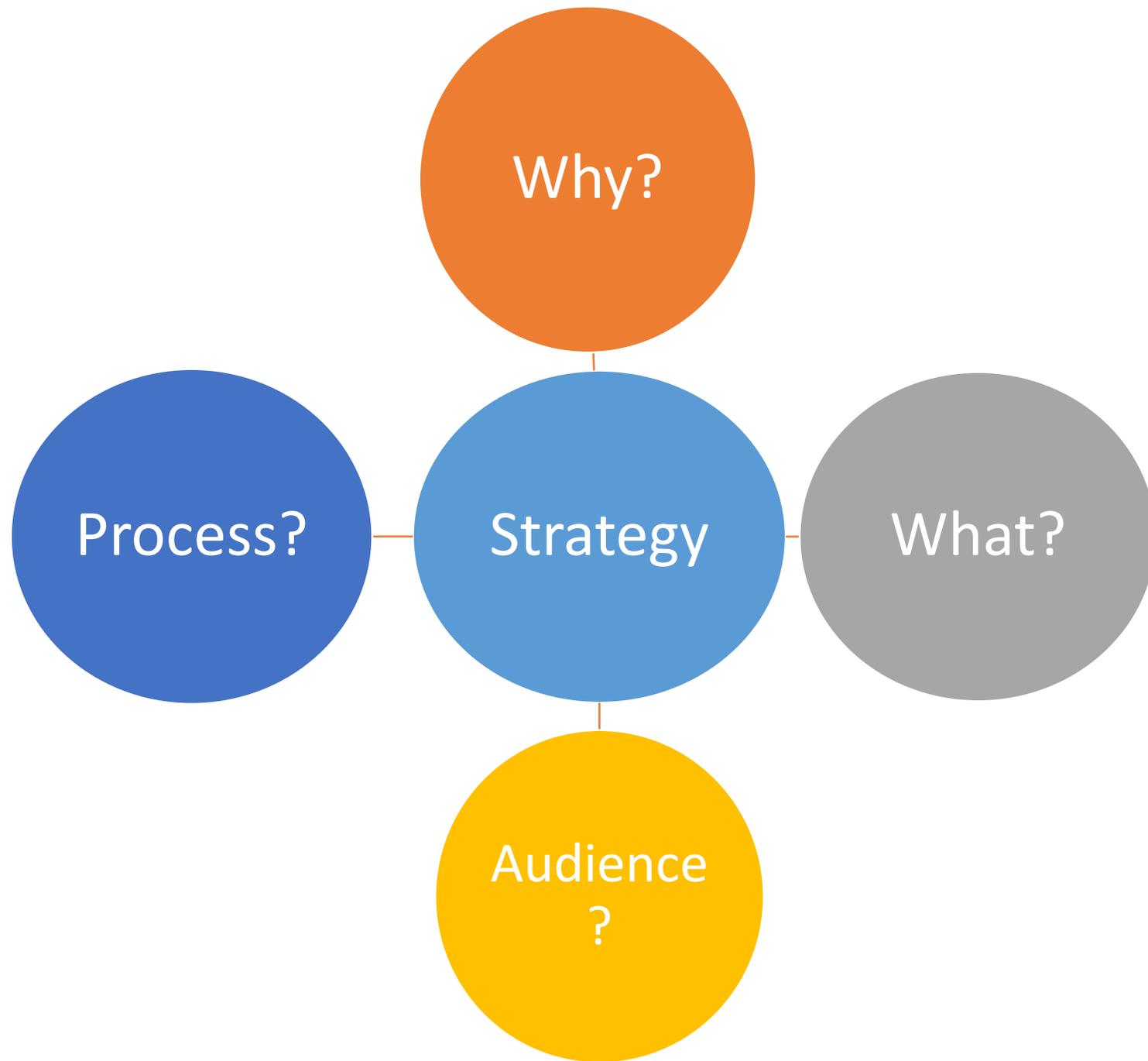
